

Shipping and Routing Instructions (Rev 01/22)

As a reminder, a requirement of doing business with Electric Boat Corporation is voluntarily complying with our facility entrance policies. With regard to material deliveries, NAVSEA Instruction 5510.2C and SUPSHIP Groton Instruction 5510.1F do not allow for lawful permanent residents (Green Card holders) to enter EB facilities. Delivery drivers must be U.S. born or naturalized persons. Please be sure delivery drivers are able to sign our Vehicle Pass for entrance which is an affidavit requiring Citizenship Declaration.

Our Quonset facility receives deliveries from 7am to 2:30pm weekdays at the 360 Callahan Road location. Our Groton facility receives deliveries from 7am to 2 pm weekdays via Contractor Gate on Eastern Point Road between Chapman Street and Nicholas Avenue.

Finally, EB does not tolerate inappropriate behavior and prohibits access in these instances.

General Instructions:

Shipments must be consolidated on one bill of lading via the same mode on any one day to the same consignee.

Freight Classification - Classify material in accordance with the National Motor Freight Classification. Shipments should be assigned a freight class which will result in the lowest transportation rate. **Do not insure or declare excess value.**

Reference Electric Boat Corporation purchase order number(s) on bill of lading or air bill and all shipping containers including all packages, boxes or crates. Instruct freight carriers to identify the same purchase order number on their delivery receipt.

Transportation Cost - When Electric Boat Purchase Order Terms states that EBC must pay freight charges, forward the shipment on a "Freight Collect" basis in lieu of prepaying and invoicing EBC the freight costs.

Electric Boat Corporation's Traffic Department should be contacted for specific routing instructions on all shipments consigned to other than Electric Boat destinations.

Collect on Delivery (COD) shipments are not authorized and will be refused.

Shipments of hazardous materials must be packed and shipped in accordance with applicable Government and carrier regulations.

Electric Boat's Traffic Department is to be notified immediately of any difficulties experienced with designated carriers at 860-433-0716.
